- Emergency Preparedness Coordinator
 - Works in Coordination w/ Greenbelt & HQ

- Hurricane Preparation and Recovery
- Aircraft Mishap Response Plan
- Severe Weather Notification Plan
- Project Contingency Plans
 - NFIRE Consolidated Emergency Response Plan
- Adhoc (Shuttle ELS)

- **WFF Fire Department**

- Emergency medical response and transport
- Fire suppression and hazardous materials response
- Aircraft crash rescue services
- 24-hour Emergency Operations Center and Incident Command
- Toxic Plume Evaluation

- **Back Up & Recovery Study Team**

- Periodic review of critical systems and backup plans to provide water, electric & other services

Emergencies and Disasters

- **Capabilities & Tools (continued)**
 - **WFF Medical Facility**
 - Staffed by one Doctor and one nurse
 - **Red Book**
 - Senior Manager Notes for Emergency Preparedness
 - Lists Events and Associated Personnel & Mission Considerations
 - Contains copies of Mishap Reporting requirements, EP Plans, radio channels, key phone numbers, etc.
 - **GETS (Government Emergency Telecommunications Service)**
 - Personnel required for Emergency Management
 - **Telework**
 - All Suborbital & Special Orbital Projects Directorate (Code 800) personnel are planned for telework capability in the event some WFF facilities are damaged.

Emergencies and Disasters

- Training/Drills
 - Fire Department has annual training in
 - Structural Fire Fighting
 - High angle rescue
 - Confined space rescue
 - Hazardous materials
 - Aircraft Rescue & Fire Fighting
 - Emergency Medical Procedures (WFF has ALS capability)
 - Miscellaneous Drills
 - WFF & County Training Day (Surface Combat Systems Center)
 - Aircraft down simulation w/ FD, Medical, Safety, Logistics
 - Hurricane preparation
 - Building Evacuation
