FY '09 Objectives

- **Prevent further erosion of Agency OH budget**
- **Complete 7 scheduled occupational health reviews (including Plumbrook in semiannual OH evaluation)**
- **Finalize EHRS commercial-off-the-shelf (COTS) selection and begin roll-out at the first Center (SSC)**



FY '09 Objectives

- **Finish revision of NPR 1800.1B by NODIS-established expiration schedule**
- **Cancel International Travel NID, NPRs 1820, 1830, and 1840 and incorporate requirements into revised NPR 1800**
- **Maintain “green” on quarterly PMA reports for Health IT interoperability**



FY '09 Objectives

- **Release finalized “Matrix G” for physical exams to OH medical community and incorporate as an appendix in revised NPR 1800.1C**
- **Fully integrate new physician capability on support contract**



Status of FY '09 *PLANNED* Objectives

- **Completed all scheduled 7 occupational health reviews**
- **Supported OSMA in Health and Safety Directors meeting (moved to KSC in 2009)**
- **Appendix/Matrix G for physical examinations posted on website and incorporated in revised NPR 1800**



Status of FY '09 *PLANNED* Objectives

- **NPR 1800.1C officially in effect**
 - One extension was needed
 - 600+ comments dispositioned
- **Unable to fully restore budget reductions**
- **Medgate selected as final COTS EHRS**



Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual Meeting

- **Unable to resolve all EHRS IT security issues**
- **Intent to issue Stop Order for Medgate hosting function prevented by period of performance.**
- **Currently preparing contract modification to bring hosting and maintenance functions inside NASA firewalls**



Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual Meeting

- **SSC EHRS Roll-out pushed back again pending resolution of hosting issues**
- **Considering measures to reduce costs and recover some of the schedule slip**
- **Quarterly Health IT Interoperability Score Card reports**
 - All submits on schedule
 - Maintained initial OMB “green” rating throughout
 - Exercise canceled by new Administration
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Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual OH Meeting

- **Renewed provision for dedicated KSC OCIO support to ensure compliance with NASA IT security thru EHRS roll-out and implementation**
 - Configuration management plan approved and signed in May
- **Uncovered issues with Medgate's U.S. hosting site.**
 - Concern re: foreign nationals potential ability access to NASA PII data



Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual OH Meeting

- **Completed annual cost and staffing reports**

Staffing

- Contractors: 357.57 FTE
- Civil Service: 36.95 FTE

Budget

Total Agency-wide: \$47,933,889

- Contractor Efforts: \$43,084,372
- Civil Service Efforts: \$4,849,517

- **Mayo Clinic HRA renewed for FY 2010**



Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual OH Meeting

- **Launched the Walk to Wellness Campaign**
- **Part-time Summer Intern utilized for OCHMO Health Promotion Programs**
- **Collaborated with OSMA on a benchmarking effort with the Medical University of South Carolina**
- **Added new management analyst position**
 - TOC was not increased
 - Admin support position was given up



Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual OH Meeting

- **Collaborated with OSMA and HR on expanded the Drug Free Workplace Program**
- **Clarified confidentiality procedures for electronic data transmission to EAP community**
- **Obama Administration initiative to decrease health costs**
 - OCHMO Contacted by OPM to discuss NASA's Health Promotion and Wellness programs





Issues and/or Accomplishments Since Last Annual OH Meeting
